Beacon Hill and Camp Sekani are a local mountain biking favorite, thanks to a dense trail system with all difficulty levels, stiff climbs, and rapid descents. Many of the trails once traversed private property, but thanks to Spokane County Conservation Futures, the eastern chapter of Evergreen Mountain Bike Alliance, Inland Northwest Land Conservancy, and other partners, many of those trails are now permanently protected for public enjoyment. First-time riders should check out Upchuck to the summit of Beacon Hill. A quick side trip leads to the Esmeralda parking lot, or continue around Airport Escalator and end where you started.

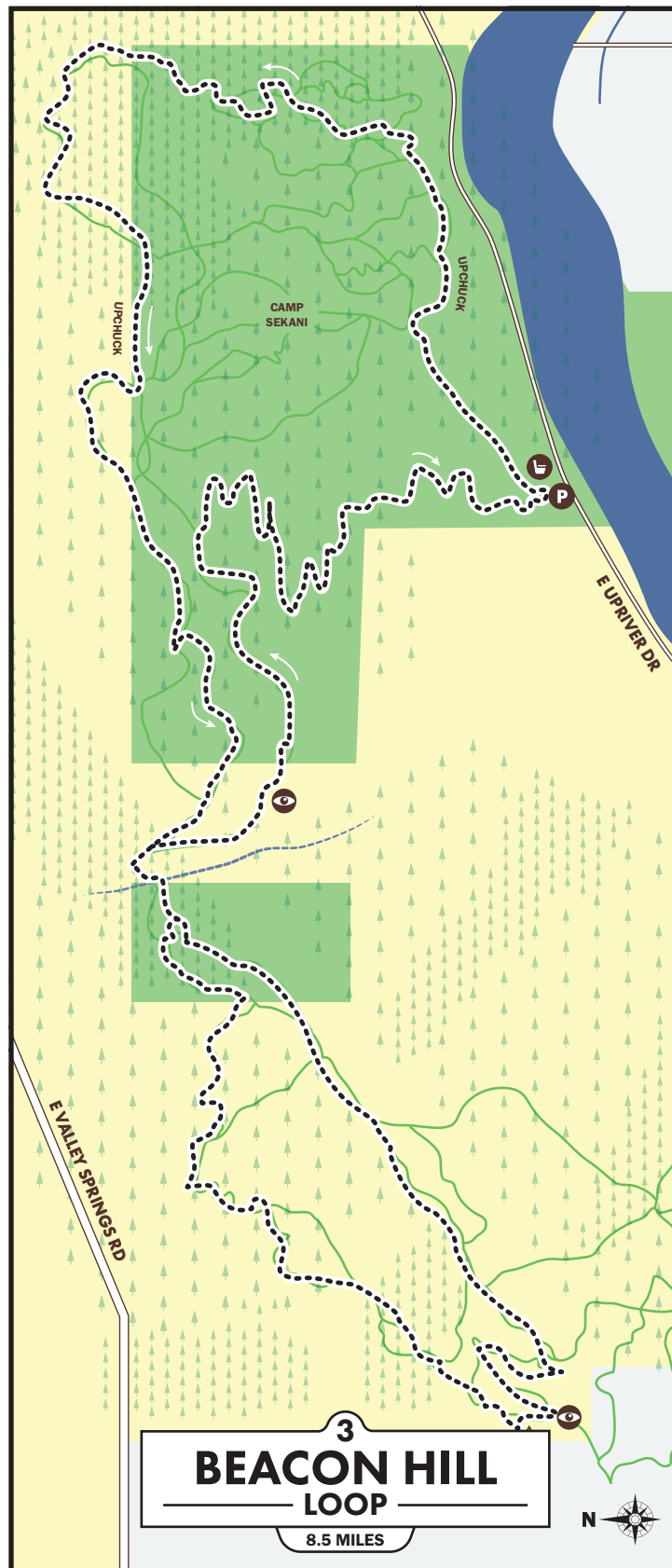
