# WAIKIKI SPRINGS

## ASTER TRAIL

EASY

Waikiki Springs Nature Preserve's trail system offers several routes with varying lengths depending on how far you want to explore. Meander up and around granite rock, through the Ponderosas, and reach views of the Little Spokane River. Pause for a moment and you can hear the water of the year-round springs for which this area was named coming from the northeast canyon walls. As you hike, look out points offer birders the opportunity to see raptors in flight and the active bald eagle nesting sites. This riparian corridor provides vital habitat for wildlife, and white tail deer, blue heron, coyote and other native species are frequently seen along the river here. Trail signs list names of wildflowers or animals that you may see along the way, and you might even share the trail itself with some animal tracks or flush up a covey of quail around your next turn.

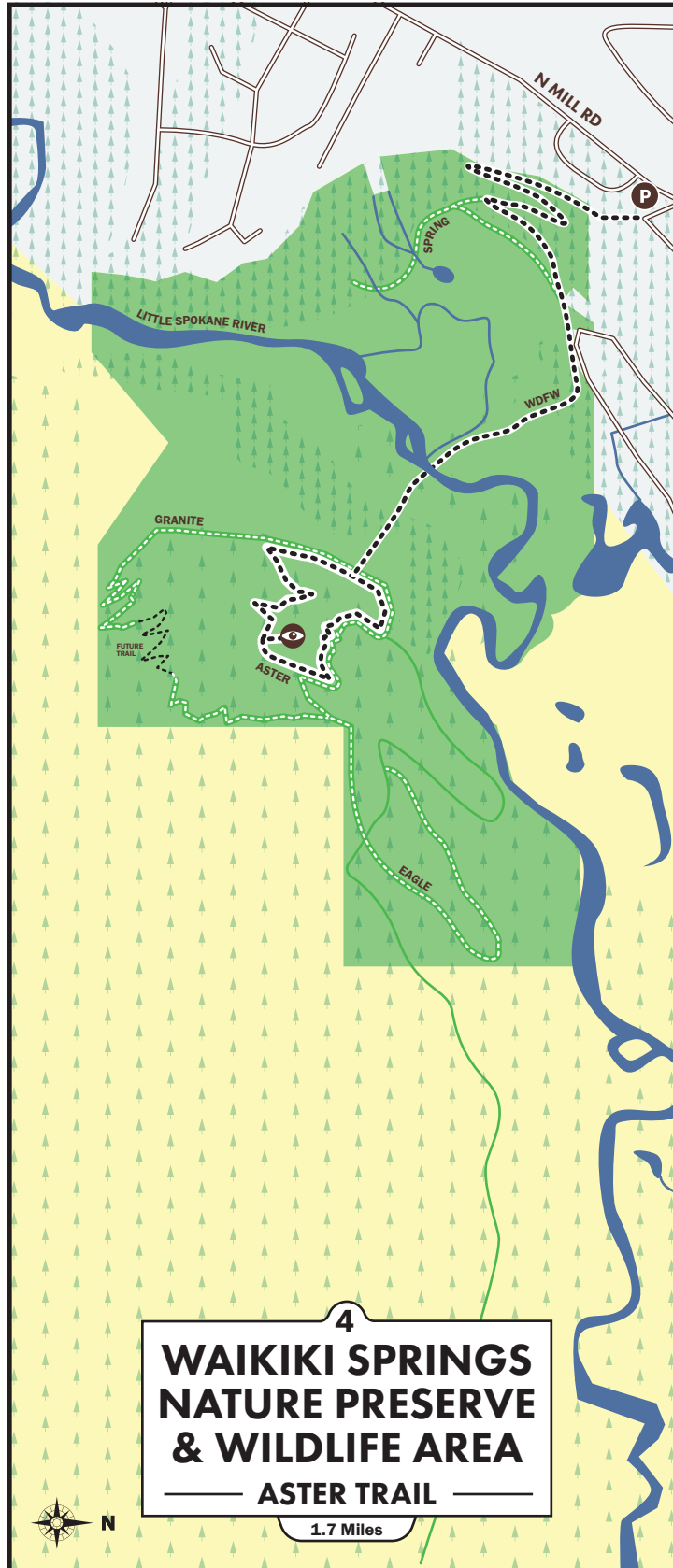
